TYPE OF EVENT: Unsafe and Dangerous Building Abated in Ridgecrest Neighborhood

LOCATION: 533 W. Inyokern Rd.

On January 18, 2009, the garage/storage area at the rear of the property located at 533 W. Inyokern Rd. caught fire and was fully engulfed. The property owner had been contacted on several occasions to have the fire debris removed from the property, and on January 16, 2015 an inspection of the property revealed the burned out structure completely removed as well as all debris. The property owner is also in the process of having a permanent fence installed at the rear of the property to ensure no unauthorized access from the alley. The Ridgecrest Police Department and Code Enforcement Division would like to thank the property owner for his effort and cooperation in abating this unsafe and dangerous building, making Ridgecrest a safer and more beautiful place to live.
